Environmentally Friendly Packaging

All Dr. McDougall's Right Foods® packaging is paper-based, helping to protect the environment by using a renewable resource. All product packaging is made exclusively with paper from Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certified sustainably managed forests. The FSC sets standards on sustainable forestry and Dr. McDougall's Right Foods® recognizes their efforts to improve the practice of forestry. The Tetra Recart Cartons and soup and oatmeal cups are also recyclable where facilities exist. Dr. McDougall's Right Foods® also is making an environmental impact by recycling at our own facility in California.

Even shipping our products has a lower carbon footprint than cans. For every truckload of Dr. McDougall's Right Foods® soup cartons, it takes nine truckloads of soup cans to make the same number of finished soups.

Genetic Modification
